- Problems in Concrete Excessive curling, scaling problems, internal/external stress

Recertification: Recertification is necessary every five years and requires successful completion of a written examination <u>OR</u> 10 hours documented continuing education from an approved source

Certification Requirements:

Associate: ACI will grant certification to those candidates who obtain a passing grade on the written examination. The two-hour written examination is closed-book and consists of approximately 50 multiple-choice questions. The passing grade for the written examination is 70%.

Finisher: ACI will grant certification to those candidates who possess 1,500 hours of *actual* <u>on-the-job finishing</u> experience (approximately one year of regular full-time work) and successfully pass the <u>performance examination</u>.

Advanced Finisher: ACI will grant certification to those candidates who obtain a passing grade on the written examination PLUS either - possess 1,500 hours of actual on-the-job finishing experience (approximately one year of regular full-time work) AND successfully complete the performance examination, OR possess 4,500 hours of actual on-the-job finishing experience (approximately three years of regular full-time work)
