The WRMCA does not own or operate trucks or ready-mix plants. Comprised of producer and associate members, overseen by its Board of Directors, and assisted by a talented professional staff comprised of an Executive Director, Public Policy Director/Lobbyist, Association Manager and Paving Consultant, the WRMCA contributes to and helps connect its members to a global knowledge community, while working collaboratively to advance the ready-mix industry in Wisconsin and the UP.
