

**ASSOCIATE ADVISORY** – Represents the interests of associate members by planning annual We're Partner's sponsorships.

**BUDGET & FINANCE** – Responsible for making recommendations to the board of directors regarding the WRMCA budget, finances, and policies.

**CERTIFICATION** – Responsible for organizing and implementing ACI Certification courses – Concrete Field-Testing Technicians – Grade 1, Strength Testing, ACI Concrete Flatwork, and other certifications.

**CONVENTION** – Organizes WRMCA annual convention including location, selection, and topics.

**LEGISLATIVE** – Responsible for monitoring local, state, and national legislation and elections, recommending to the board of director's positions to be taken on issues and candidates.

**LONG RANGE PLANNING** – Recommends and reviews the implementation of the association's long-range goals; reviews the association's By-laws as needed and makes suggestions for updates.

**MEMBERSHIP** – Promotes membership growth, retention, and recognition.

**MIXER DRIVER CHAMPIONSHIP** – Organizes the mixer driver championship.

**OPERATIONS, ENVIRONMENTAL & SAFETY (OES)** – The OES Committee members, through their shared experiences, provide a forum for discussion of industry issues in the arena of operations management, environmental, and safety compliance. The OES committee also provides leadership to address urgent regulatory issues considered detrimental to the ready-mixed industry.

**PROMOTION (STATEWIDE)** – Coordinates ongoing statewide promotion programs including seminars, advertising, public relations, education efforts, and annual Concrete Design Awards. There are five regional promotional groups that have their own committees: Southwest Region, Southeast Region, Northeast Region, North Central Region and Northwest Region.

**SCHOLARSHIP & EDUCATION** – Responsible for coordinating the WRMCA annual scholarship program. Organizes the annual Ready Mixed Blitz Golf Outing and Pheasant Hunt, raising funds for scholarships for students.

**TECHNICAL** – Responsible for keeping membership current on technical related issues in the industry. Meets with WisDOT and NRCS agencies on behalf of members. Organizes the annual concrete technical workshop.
