Access & Visibility

Active members interact with key industry leaders at WRMCA meetings, workshops, fundraising events, the mixer driver championship, and the annual convention. Members use the WRMCA as a networking forum, heightening their company's profile in the ready-mix industry. Members are listed on our online directory on the WRMCA website.

Education

Education and networking events are offered through the OES workshop, the technical workshop, and the convention on relevant concrete topics. WRMCA is the sponsoring group for various ACI certifications, Concrete Field Testing Technician-Grade 1, Strength Testing Technician, and Flatwork Finisher Certification. Members get discounted rates for some ACI courses.

Legislative

Monitor legislation affecting the concrete industry, hold an annual Legislative Day at the Capitol, raise conduit funds to support key legislators, and assist members with scheduling plant tours.

Promotion

Provides vital information about the industry and the many benefits of concrete construction through the website and annual concrete design awards. A paving consultant educates design build firms and assists producers and contractors with alternate bids on projects. Promotion of concrete on a regional level is done through various advertising such as Google ads, LinkedIn ads, email marketing, print ads, and social media.

Operations, Environmental & Safety

The OES committee provides a forum for discussion and leadership to address regulatory issues pertinent to the industry. Maintains relationships with OSHA, MSHA, and DNR. Works with DNR on permit renewals affecting members' operations. Holds annual Plant Safety awards, Driver of the Year awards, and Delivery Professional Recognition Week.
